### How to Apply

You may apply at any Workforce West Virginia Job Service Office. You must complete an application and if you don't have a high school diploma or equivalent (GED), then you must take a TABE Test. Please check at your local WorkForce office for testing information. WorkForce hours of operation are Monday through Thursday from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. and Friday from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. If you have any questions regarding applying, you may call Parkersburg WorkForce Job Service Office 304-420-4525.

### Eligibility Requirements

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Possess a valid driver's license
- Be physically able to perform the duties of the craft
- Pass a physical exam and a drug test
- Possess a high school diploma or equivalent or pass a TABE test given at WorkForce with a score of 8.0 or above

### Training

Apprentices will be required to attend a total of 408 hours of classroom and hands-on training at the West Virginia Laborers' Training Center in Mineral Wells (Parkersburg), West Virginia where instruction, meals and lodging will be provided free of charge. In order to complete the program, apprentices will earn an appropriate wage rate while receiving 4000 hours of on-the-job training on construction projects in their home areas.
