RE: WARN Notification Regarding Closure of Facility

To Whom It May Concern:

As previously announced, this letter is to inform you that Mylan Pharmaceuticals, Inc. (the “Company”) will close its manufacturing facility and adjacent East Office Building at its Chestnut Ridge, Morgantown, West Virginia site in Monongalia County and that this will constitute a permanent plant closing and termination of operations under the federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (“WARN”). Accordingly, this letter constitutes the required WARN Notice to the above government officials that a permanent plant closing and termination of operations will occur. The expected date of cessation of manufacturing operations is July 31, 2021, with limited winddown and closure activities continuing after that date, possibly through March 31, 2022. This information is based on the best information currently available but may change due to subsequent circumstances.

2. The entire Mylan Pharmaceuticals, Inc. Chestnut Ridge Road facility will be closed. The planned action is expected to be permanent, and the expected date of cessation of manufacturing operations is July 31, 2021, with limited winddown and closure activities continuing after that date, possibly through March 31, 2022.

3. It is expected that a total estimate of 1431 employees will be laid off or separated from employment as a result of the plant closing.
 The expected date for the first separations of non-union represented employees is July 31, 2021 (482 employees). The anticipated schedule for future separations of non-union represented employees is August 31, 2021, October 31, 2021, December 31, 2021, and March 31, 2022.
 The expected date for the first layoffs of union represented employees is July 31, 2021 (764 employees). The anticipated schedule for future layoffs of union represented employees is August 31, 2021, October 31, 2021, December 31, 2021, and March 31, 2022.
