## Dear Director Persons:

I am writing on behalf of Civil, LLC to give you notice that there will be a layoff at the Beckley Mechanic Shop facility located at 2251 Robert C Byrd Dr., Beckley, WV 25801 beginning on or about August 2, 2025. This layoff is expected to be permanent. The entire operation will close.

All affected employees have been notified of their separation dates and that their separation from employment will be permanent. Those employees are expected to be separated from employment beginning on August 2, 2025, with all separations accomplished by August 15, 2025.
