Dear Director Persons:

I am writing on behalf of Civil, LLC to give you notice that there will be a layoff at the Eagle Energy facility located at 1950 Eagle Mine Road, Kimberly, WV 25118 beginning on or about August 2, 2025. This layoff is expected to be permanent. The entire operation will close.

All affected employees have been notified of their separation dates and that their separation from employment will be permanent. Those employees are expected to be separated from employment beginning on August 2, 2025, with all separations accomplished by August 15, 2025.
